Live at last, town's app available for download

A new smart phone app for Tenterden has now gone live and is available to download.

The 'My Tenterden' app, which launched on Monday of last week, allows visitors to make the most of the town known as the 'Jewel of the Weald'.

Users can browse local news and things to do in the area, explore places of interest, find facilities such as nearby toilets and get directions.

The free app, which ties in with the My Tenterden website, also provides special offers through push notifications, weather forecasts and accommodation.

Tenterden councillor Sue Ferguson and marketing firm WillCreate in Bethersden asked developers to come up with the bespoke app to promote Tenterden, which it is hoped will also be a useful tool for residents.

Cllr Ferguson said: "We have been waiting for this for so long.

"We have still got work to do on it. I think it can only get better.

"The website's going from strength to strength and the app will go that way, too. It is wonderful that the offers are creating quite an interest.

"It's really good to have this facility for businesses. I hope it grows in popularity."
