



# Council chews over problem

Chewing gum on pavements may be tackled by a special action team.

The sticky problem was raised by Cllr Sue Ferguson at a Tenterden Town Council meeting on Monday.

She said that the amount of gum on pavements had increased and was a problem.

Ashford Borough Council (ABC) had a town centre

action team (TCAT) whose remit was to keep Ashford clean.

“What about Tenterden?” she said. “This team is funded by the council. It sorts out chewing gum so is there any way it can spend time in Tenterden occasionally?”

The council has agreed to write to Ashford council asking for the TCAT team to visit.
