

Noticeboard to prioritise local matters

Local events should take priority for advertisements on the Tenterden council noticeboard.

That was the view of town councillors when discussing in what order community notices should be put on the board outside the council offices.

Mayor Cllr Robin Wade said local people had complained about not being able to get notices on the board because it was full, while some of those on it did not relate to Tenterden.

He suggested priorities should be town council events, then local ones then everything else.

Cllr Sue Ferguson said only local events should be displayed.

“It is a shame that local things cannot go on the noticeboard because there is information about events in Benenden and Faversham,” she said.

Councillors agreed Cllr Ferguson should look into the matter.
