Open sure signal is a small 3G mobile base station which works with a local broadband connec-

tion to create a 3G signal.

Each unit provides up to 500 metres of 3G coverage and 10 properties are needed in each

area to host the boxes.

They are installed by mobile phone company Vodafone and the only cost to the host build-

ing is an electricity bill of around £30 a year.

In the Tenterden and St Michael's area, properties which are interested include Stanley George, London Beach Hotel, Trinity Baptist Church, Zion Baptist Church, the town hall, Badsha Indian restaurant, Bell House/Nelson McLean, CB Motors, Kench Hill, Tenterden House Interiors at Leigh Green

Industrial Estate, Homewood School, Tesco and the flat above Norman Holmes jewellery shop.

Cllr Ferguson added: "Thankyou to all the groups and businesses who are helping with this exciting community-led scheme, which will bring Vodafone 3G to St Michael's and Tenterden, if we are chosen"
